ANIMAL TECH, NATIONAL SHOW OF LIVESTOCK AND NATIONAL HUNTING SHOW WERE RECORD-BREAKING IN 2023

The ANIMAL TECH International Fair For Animal Production, the National Show of Livestock and the National Hunting Show were held in 2023 in an extraordinary period of five days. The number of visitors exceeded 50 thousand. The breeders' programme was exceptionally rich, featuring championships and competition cattle shows, and horse breeders' shows. The programme included celebrations of the 100th anniversary of the foundation of the Czech-Moravian Hunting Union. An exhibition of unique trophies was set up at the exhibition centre, a European Championship in deer calling, and a hunting ball took place.

Zdeněk Nekula, Minister of Agriculture of the Czech Republic

Although the ANIMAL TECH fair is primarily intended for professionals, I think that the general public will also find something of interest here.
